



The Children of the Forest Children's Protection Centre

The COF Children's Protection Centre is divided into five separate children's houses onsite at COF organised by age and gender. Each house is overseen by a live- in house mother who cares for and monitors the progress of the children in that house. The house mothers have received formal child protection training and also regularly report to a child protection supervisor and child protection committee. COF has an organisation-wide and regularly updated child protection policy based on UN best practice guidelines. The children that are resident at the COF protection centre are supported by COF to attend elementary school or high school in Sangkhlaburi. Currently there are 104 children resident across the five houses within the protection centre.

The children's protection centre is vital to COF's work. The children living there really have nowhere else to go when they come to us. Other organisations in Sangkhlaburi working with migrant children often refer at-risk children in crisis situations to COF for residential care. This is an essential need in Sangkhlaburi where many migrant children are abandoned, abused or orphaned. The border zone between Thailand and Myanmar contains many risks to these children's safety and well being, such as forced or exploitative labour and human trafficking.

Due to reductions in funding from some long-term donors, COF is facing a substantial funding shortfall that will affect the ongoing operation of the Children's Protection Centre. Your support for the protection centre will make a real difference for the current 104 children resident in the protection centre at present and for many others who will need its services into the future.
